# "Creative Strategies of Sustainability"

## About the seminar

Within the framework of the *Engine Room Europe* project of the European network *Trans Europe Halles*, the German partner ufaFabrik Berlin, organises a week of seminar around the theme "Culture and sustainability", and more specifically on the "Creative strategies of sustainability for artistic and cultural centres in Europe".

This seminar for cultural operators proposes a common reflection and a time of intense experiences sharing around the potential "creative strategies of sustainability" that the participants can initiate for their own professional backgrounds. It is a unique opportunity for a relevant work, discussion and discovery of some practical examples of existing practices. It will be composed by six full-days of activities including: workshops, lectures, exploring sustainable places and projects in Berlin, initiation about straw bale building, artistic expression, social interaction and more.

The number of the participants is limited to 20 and the deadline for fill-up the online registration is the 23<sup>rd</sup> of April 2012. The language of the seminar will be English.

#### About the ufaFabrik Berlin

The International Culture Centre ufaFabrik is a green cultural oasis in the middle of Berlin - a space for creation, culture and innovative ideas. The 18.600 square meters former UFA-film factory grounds are open all year round, offering artistic productions, community activities and ecological projects. The ufaFabrik's unique programme attracts about 150.000 visitors per year.

## Programme

The schedule is already well prepared. However, it is still possible to include some aspects that the participants will bring in.

#### What is provided during the seminar ?

All the costs concerning the daily programme, trainers, workshops, visits, activities and materials are covered.

<u>Travel costs</u>: We will cover moderate travel costs. For coming to Berlin, you have a many possibilities from all over Europe: train, plane, boat, bus, carpool, or by bicycle.

<u>Accommodation</u>: Six nights in a **shared** double room are provided for free in the guesthouse of the ufaFabrik. Don't worry, the rooms are big and all have a loft. The idea is to enjoy and share the familiar atmosphere of the guesthouse, and get to know each other better. If you desire a single room in a pension in the neighbourhood you will have to pay an additional fee.

You have also the possibility to take care of your accommodation by yourself. In this case, all the accommodation costs will be on your charge.

<u>Food</u>: We will charge everybody a small fee related to the financial standards in the home country, based on the International List for Travel Costs Refund.

The 12 co-organisers present a programme of actions including artistic productions, festivals, conferences, research, staff exchanges and a volunteer programme. An open source online platform will hold the memory of the project and collect views, experiences and processes.
